

« ÉTUDIANT » RESIDENCE PERMIT

AND « VISITEUR » (SPOUSES)

This list only applies if you do not have access to the online national platform of the Directorate-General for Foreign Nationals in France (DGEF)

For each document, please bring the original and a photocopy. IMPORTANT: Documents written in a language other than French must be translated by a sworn translator accredited by French courts.

Common documents:

- □ Passport, with the copy of the identity page
- Current residence permit: card or visa plus the copy of the first and last stamp of entry in France/Schengen Area
 - If it's a long stay visa equivalent to a residence permit (VLS-TS), add: the proof of its online validation (« Confirmation de la validation de l'enregistrement de votre visa long séjour valant titre de séjour »)
 - If it's a visa « étudiant-concours », provide in addition the certificate of achievement and the certificate issued by the French embassy or consulate
- □ If you are married: family record book or marriage certificate
- "Fiche de renseignements" form, filled in and signed
- □ 3 recent ID photos taken in France (following the 35 mm x 45 mm format ISO/IEC 19794 5 : 2005 standard)
- □ A proof of address dated less than 6 months in your name:

Electricity, gas, water, phone or Internet bill; house insurance certificate (« *Attestation d'assurance habitation* »); certificate from your student residence (« *Attestation de résidence universitaire* »); rental contract or receipt/bill (if dated less than 6 months); « *Taxe d'habitation* » (if dated less than 6 months); Hotel statement (dated less than one month) and copy of the last bill.

If you are accommodated by someone:

- « Attestation d'hébergement » form filled in and signed by the person accommodating you;
- copy of the valid ID of this person (French/European ID or French residence permit; if it's a residence permit card the address must be up to date);
- A recent proof of address (less than 6 months) in this person's name
- □ Proof of monthly financial resources at least equivalent to 615€
 <u>Important:</u> bank statements must show the amounts in euro, and need to be stamped and signed.
 - Option 1: Bank statement (such as « *synthèse des soldes* » ou « *relevé de situation client* ») certifying that you have at least 6150€ on your account balance (dated less than 1 month).
 - Option 2: « Attestation sur l'honneur de prise en charge » form filled in and signed by your guarantor with the documents listed in the form (including the bank transfer order to your account for the academic year).
 - \circ Option 3: Recent scholarship certificate mentioning the amount in euros and the duration of the scholarship.
 - \circ $\,$ Option 4: Work contract with copies of the 3 last pay slips

Students:

- Certificate of enrollment (or pre-enrollment letter from your school or university)
- "Cursus scolaire" form, filled in and signed
- Academic transcripts of the past year (except PhD students), and last diploma obtained in France (if available).

Spouses of students:

- □ Certificate of enrollment of your spouse
- Déclaration sur l'honneur de n'exercer aucune activité professionnelle" form, filled in and signed.
