POSITION DETAILS

The STAR program (Study Abroad Representatives) gives you the opportunity to get the most out of your experience as an international exchange student.

Student ambassadors will be a vector for the Students will work with their home university to promote the UGA at an international level. They will also promote their university and culture with contributors at the UGA.



CORE TASKS

Student representatives are tasked with promoting the UGA at their home institution, as well as promoting their country and home institution with contributors at the UGA. This includes:

- Providing testimonials during your exchange period. These testimonials may be articles, videos, podcasts, photo essays, etc. They will mainly be adapted for social media, but other formats may be considered. Training will be given beforehand by UGA services as well as their partners.
- Advising students considering exchange periods in your country of origin.
- Participating as much as possible in international promotional events and cultural meetings with contributors at the UGA.
- Transmitting relevant information regarding the UGA to students, teachers or personnel at your home university after returning back from your exchange period.

SUPPORT PROVIDED

The Promotion and Internationalisation Division will guide you in your tasks by providing:

- An introduction to relevant issues and messages
- Training focusing on communication and photography
- STAR certification, adding value to your role
- Opportunities to meet with other representatives and contributors involved in the promotion of the UGA
