Language requirements for French and english	The exchange program guidelines establish that student must have sufficient knowledge of the <u>French language</u> . To attest the level in French and/or English, student must provide either an official test, a certificate from a language instructor stating the <u>CECR Level equivalence</u> .
	<ul> <li>For exchange students, a B1 level is recommended in French and in English depending if they choose courses in English or in French).</li> </ul>
	<ul> <li>For double-degree students, a B1 level is recommended in French and in English but a B2 level will be necessary to obtain the engineering degree.</li> </ul>

French grading system	Grenoble INP – UGA uses the European Credit Transfer System (ECTS). One
	academic year corresponds to 60 ECTS, one semester to 30 ECTS. Exchange
	students take a maximum of 30 ECTS per semester or 60 ECTS per year.

Deadline for nominations	<ul> <li>Full academic year or Fall semester: April 15<sup>th</sup></li> <li>Spring semester: October 25<sup>th</sup></li> <li>Note: Grenoble INP – Esisar, our School in Advanced Systems and Networks doesn't accept nominations for Spring semester only.</li> </ul>
Application	Incoming students have to complete an online application form (there is no need to send documents by e-mail or mail).
